# Does your child have, or is suspected to have, a learning difficulty or disability?

Pupils have a right to special arrangements that offer equal opportunities to those with a learning difficulty or disability. This is a normal process and we would expect roughly 10% of any year group to benefit from such provision. Examples cover a wide range: for example, attention deficiency, dyslexia, hearing loss, autism, physical disability, ...

Specifically for the European Baccalaureate, you should take initial steps before the end of S3 or on enrollment to the school if later.

The process to establish the arrangements can take several months and must be completed for submission by 15th October at the start of S5 to allow implementation for the Baccalaureate cycle in S6 and S7.

Your starting point is to contact the ESEB service at the school (eseb@eide.lu), in order to:

- discuss the process of diagnosis where one does not yet exist
- update an existing diagnosis, given that for the European Baccalaureate it must be less than 2 years old at the time of submission
- obtain the "Template for the requesting of special arrangements for the European Baccalaureate cycle (S6-S7)", which should be shown to a professional who establishes the diagnosis so that recommendations are in line with the provisions available. This document and further guidance is also available in the folder "Educational Support" of files stored on the Student Portal.

An initial reference to ESEB can be made by the pupils themselves, or on their behalf by their parents/legal guardians or their tutors or subject teachers.

Final submission to the school of the template and supporting documentation is the responsibility of parents/legal guardians, or the pupil if over eighteen.

# Important Dates to Be Respected Concerning Choices for Years 4 and 5

June 15<sup>th</sup> 2026 Deadline for requests to change options for S3 students going into S4-S5. September 18<sup>th</sup> 2026 Deadline for requesting a change <u>recommended by the S3 class council</u>.

No request will be accepted in September unless the Class Council has recommended it.

January 15<sup>th</sup> 2027 Deadline for requesting a change of Maths level for second semester.

Test required for Maths 6.

June 15<sup>th</sup> 2027 Deadline for requesting a change of Maths level for S5.

Test required for Maths 6.

N.B. No request will be accepted in September unless the Class Council has recommended it.

A positive response is not guaranteed for any requested change.
